Constitution

As Per Transition February 21, 2018

1. The name of the society is Abbotsford Bingo Association (formally changed at Registry May 15, 1996 from Marshall Road Bingo Association)

2. The purposes of the Association are:

- (a) to establish and maintain an Association for the purposes of promoting the economic and social welfare of the community and its members by providing the facilities and/or venue for recreational activities within the community;
- (b) to provide support for non-profit organizations engaged in assisting the economic and social development of the community;
- (c) to promote interest in the Association amongst organizations, individual members of the public and municipal, provincial and federal governments who may be able to assist in all ways in attaining the Association's objectives; and
- (d) to perform such other acts and things as are incidental to or necessary for the advancement of the purposes of the association to enable the Association to achieve its purposes.
- (e) carried out without purpose of gain for its members and any income, profit or other accretions to the association shall be used for promoting the purposes of the association.
